AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE TAX ON GROSS RECEIPTS OF PLACES FOR EATING IN THE VILLAGE OF NORTH RIVERSIDE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of North Riverside, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended.

WHEREAS, as authorized by state law, the Village currently levies and imposes upon owners of places for eating a one percent (1%) tax on gross receipts for prepared food sold at retail by the owners as detailed in Section 3.30.010, *et seq.*, of the Village of North Riverside Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, as discussed at the public meeting of the Finance Committee on May 23, 2016, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Riverside find it necessary and in the best interests of the Village to increase this tax to two percent (2%) of gross receipts, as permitted by state law, to assist the Village in meeting increasing budget demands and financial obligations and to continue providing necessary services for its residents and businesses, among other needs.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Riverside, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS.

That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2: The tax set forth in Chapter 3.30 of the Village Code, entitled “TAX ON THE GROSS RECEIPTS OF PLACES FOR EATING,” is increased from 1% to 2% by deleting the struck terms and adding the underscored terms in Section 3.30.020(a) as follows:

3.30.020 – Tax imposed.

- (a) Effective July 1, 2016, there is hereby levied and imposed upon owners of places for eating a tax at the rate of one~~two~~ percent of gross receipts received for prepared food sold at retail by the owner ~~on or after August 1, 2010.~~

SECTION 3: REPEALER.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

This Ordinance, and every provision thereof, shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and provisions and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




