AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE MAXIMUM VIDEO GAMING LIQUOR LICENSES
IN THE VILLAGE OF NORTH RIVERSIDE,
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of North Riverside, Cook County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended;

WHEREAS, the Village is granted authority by the Illinois Liquor Control Act over the types and numbers of liquor licenses established in the Village;

WHEREAS, in recent years the Village has amended its liquor classifications and altered the number of licenses issued therein to better reflect and regulate the varied businesses, clubs, and/or events opening in the Village and applying for liquor licenses and to more effectively enforce its licensing requirements and restrictions for the protection of residents, businesses, and customers; and

WHEREAS, to further these efforts, the corporate authorities have deemed it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents and businesses to update and adjust the available liquor licenses available in the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Riverside, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS.

That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 5, Section 5.02.030 E. of the Village Code is amended by adding the underscored language as follows:

- E. Maximum Number of Licenses Issued. There shall be issued in the village zero Class A, no more than three Class A-1, no more than nine Class B, no more than two Class B-1, no more than one Class C, no more than ten Class D, no more than one Class F, no more than three Class G, no more than five Class G-1, no more than three Class H, and zero Class I licenses. Irrespective of the maximum number of Class G and Class G-1 licenses either permitted or issued under this section, respectively, no more than a total of ten such establishments, as allowed by the Illinois Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1), and qualifying for either a Class G or Class G-1 license under this Code, shall be permitted to operate within the Village at one time. Upon application, Class E licenses are granted at the discretion of the liquor control commissioner who shall also determine the maximum number of such licenses available during a given period.

SECTION 3: REPEALER.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

This Ordinance, and every provision hereof, shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and provisions and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE.

These amendments shall be in full force and effect from and after the Ordinance's passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law and shall accordingly apply to all pending and new applications received by the Village for a liquor license or licenses.
