The applicant certifies that neither he/she nor any member of his/her family has conducted a similar sale in the twelve (12) months preceding this application. **ONLY ONE GARAGE PER YEAR IS PERMITTED ACCORDING TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 73-O-10 THIS PERMIT IS LIMITED TO FRIDAY, SATURDAY AND SUNDAY ONLY.** The applicant certifies that no sale items shall be conducted in the front or yard area of the subject premises, or on any public sidewalk, parkway area or other public property.

The applicant further certifies that he/she shall post advertising for the sale only in the front yard area of the premises.

The applicant agrees to abide by all the requirement set by the State of Illinois regarding conducting a garage sale during COVID-19.

Chapter 5.50 - GARAGE, LAWN, AND BASEMENT SALES

5.50.010 - Permit—Required.

It is unlawful for any person, resident, tenant, owner, agent, or occupant of any dwelling, building, flat, or apartment to conduct or manage a garage, lawn, or basement sale without first having obtained a permit from the village granting permission to conduct such a sale.

5.50.020 - Permit—Terms.

- A. Any permit issued under this chapter shall be limited to one weekend only, including Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- B. There shall be no fee charged for such a permit.
- C. Only one permit per calendar year shall be issued to any household of the village; said permit shall be prominently displayed on the residence where the sale is to be held.
- D. No such sale shall commence before the hour of nine a.m. nor extend beyond six p.m.
- E. Sales items purchased for initial sale or resale may not be sold from a private residence.

5.50.030 - Signs.

- A. No poster, placard, or sign advertising such a sale shall be placed on any public street, village parkway or village sign or light pole.
- B. Any and all posters, placards, and signs placed on private property advertising said sale shall be removed immediately after the sale.
